CO-ED LEARN TO PLAY GOLF 2006

KCE is now accepting registration for a seven week Learn to Play Golf program for boys and girls in grades 3-8.

The first three weeks of this program are held in the Golf Dome with two hours of group lessons taught by the Golf Dome staff each week. The second part of the program is held at our home course, Fowler's Mill. Each week for four weeks, participants will play either a six-hole (3-5 grade) or nine-hole (6-8 grade) round of golf.

Enrollment is limited to 16 participants per day/time.

Each participant should have his/her own set of clubs. A full set is not needed, but each participant should have a putter, wood and iron. Golf shoes are not necessary.
